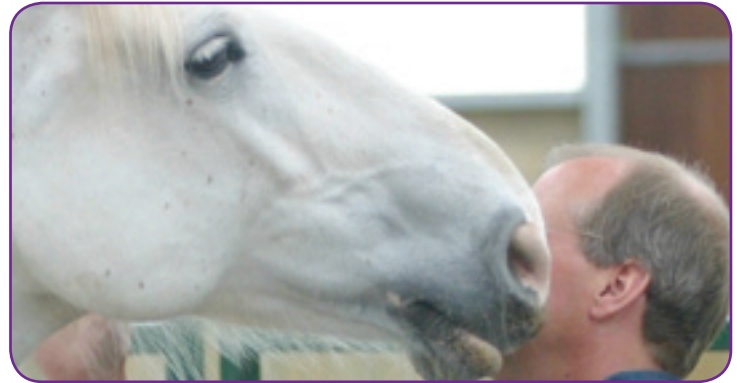


Coach and Horses
